
FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM






YOGA DAY CELEBRATION

ANTI RAGGING CELL



- 5. After fulfilling admission formalities student must obtain identity Card on duly payment of fees from the office of the college.
- 6. Student should complete the formality of Enrolment with University after getting admission in the college.
- 7. Students are directed to give their correct address and telephone number in the admission form. Any change/changes in this regard student should bring to the notice of the college in writing.
- 8. Once fees is paid to the college it should not be refunded in any circumstances. Payment of fees for session will be in advance as decides by the college.
- 9. Caution Money shall be refunded on completion of full term of the courses on submitting the original receipt of payment of fees with application only. If student leaves the institution in between the session then also fees shall not be refundable.
- 10. The student will be liable to pay all dues/fees for the full session even in the case of leaving the college without the completing the session.
- 11. The transfer certificate (T.C.) will be issued by the college only after the payment of all dues.
- 12. No concession in fees will be granted.
- 13. Students shall abide by the code of conduct rules and regulations of the college, as declared and notified time to time.
- 14. Students should not be indulge in any unsocial, criminal or political activity in the college campus.
- 15. As per the norms of University minimum 75% attendance of student is required to be eligible to appear in the University examination.
- 16. In case of damage/ destroy of property of college the student shall be punishable and liable to pay fine as the case may be.
- 17. Consumption of Tobacco products, Alcohol, Gutkha, Gaanja etc. in the campus is strictly prohibited. Students will be punished/rusticated if indulged in such activities.
- 18. Gadgets like Mobile Phones, Walkman, Radio etc. are not allowed in the classrooms, workshops and seminars place. College can seize these gadgets from the user.
- 19. Publication of any information regarding the institute without prior permission from the competent authority is not allowed and shall be treated as an offence invoking punitive action.
- 20. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in accordance and as per directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. STUDENTS FOUND INDULGED IN SUCH ACTICITY WILL BE OUTRIGHTLY RUSTICATED FROM COLLEGEAND LEGALACTION AS PRESCRIBED MAY BE INITIATED.
- 21. Library, Computer Lab, Seminar hall etc, are governed separately by the rules of college as notified time to time.
- 22. Indiscipline act shall be reported to the Disciplinary Committee and the decision of the Committee shall be final and abiding.
- 23. Information of examinations, co-curricular activities etc. shall be displayed on the Notice Boards.
- 24. The students will not be allowed to enter in the college premises without valid ID card.
- 25. College ground will only be used for sports and parking purposes and will not be permissible for any other activities like annual function etc.
- 26. No financial aid will be provided to the students for farewell, freshers party, picnic or other such activity.
- 27. Students are not allowed to invite outsider in the college campus.
